- PMJVK (Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram)

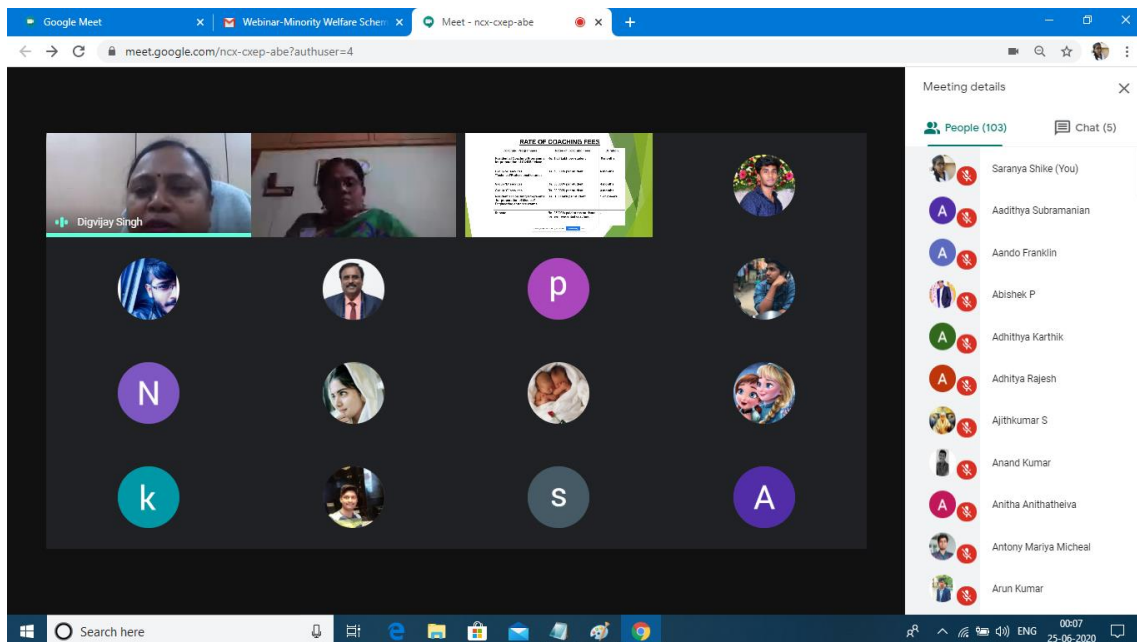
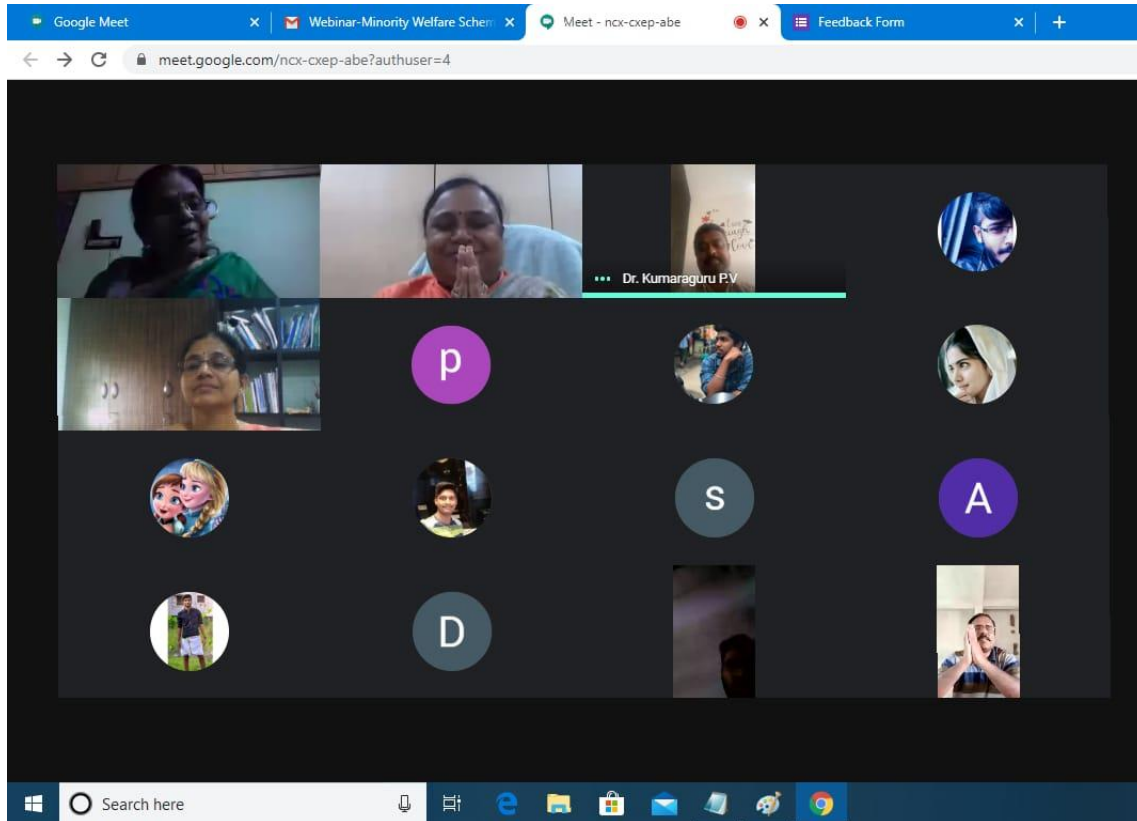
