


# **Rang Rangilo Rajasthan- Quiz on History and Culture of Rajasthan**




## **PARTICIPATION-**

## **ORGANISERS OF THE EVENT-**




Prof. Gautam Barua, Director-IIITG keenly observes the EBSB activities in the institute and promotes the EBSB events.
