Every Saturday, Home Learning program includes a session on different themes aligned with EBSB and connected to paired states Gujarat and Chhattisgarh.

❖ **Information Regarding Each session of April 2021**

- **Session 1: April 3rd, 2021:** The telecast was focussed to inform Students, Teachers and others about tourist places in the paired states. The Facilitator introduced the following tourist places in paired states during the session:

- **Session 3: April 17th, 2021:** In the third Sessions of the Month, Students Were Informed About Various Historical places of both the States.

- **Session 4: April 24th, 2021:** During fourth Session of the month, Students were Introduced to 30 Sentences in the languages of paired States. This session also mentioned about Surendra Dubey a famous Hindi poet from Chhattisgarh and Kunwar Bai Yadav, brand ambassador of Chhattisgarh for Swachh Bharat.

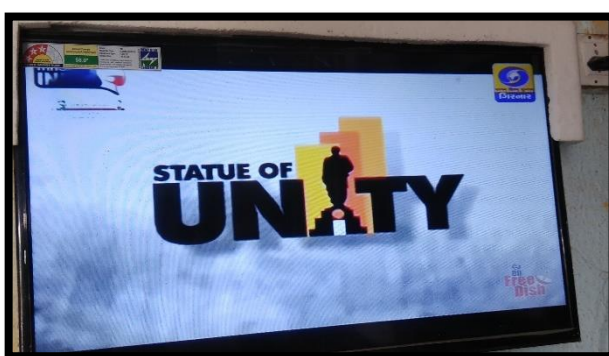

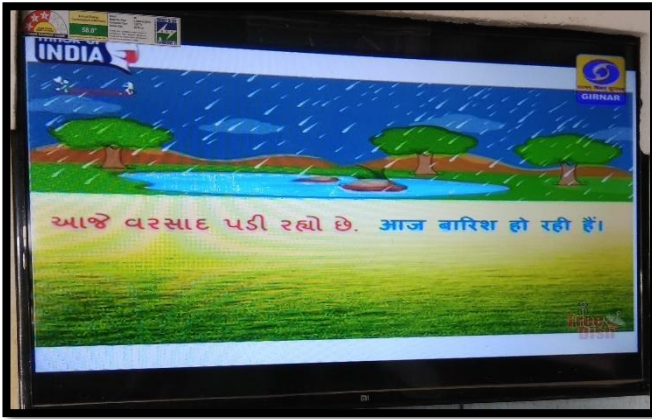
