



### "NATIONAL ROAD SAFETY WEEK 2023" (11 TO 17 JANUARY)

Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College Dinanagar under the able guidance of principal Dr. Reena Talwar Under Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat mission celebrated "National Road Safety Week 2023" (11 to 17 January). Principal Dr. Reena Talwar told that "National Road Safety Week" is celebrated every year from 11 to 17 January. Road safety is one of the biggest concerns in today's time. The theme for the year 2023 is 'Sadak Suraksha Jeevan Raksha'. She told that the aim to celebrate this week is to raise public awareness about traffic rules. The campaign emphasizes various measures that people should take to comply with the government's safety regulations and, as a result, keep themselves and their loved ones safe. She threw light upon preventive measures for road safety i.e., to adopt safety measures like wearing seat belt, helmet while driving and riding, not to do things like wearing make-up, combing hair or talking on the phone while driving. Road traffic safety is a method or measure that attempts to reduce the incidence of road accidents causing injury and death to people. All road users, including pedestrians, cyclists, drivers of vehicles or those using public transport should always follow the traffic rules. During this day various activities i.e., chetna rally, Pledge taking ceremony and lectures were carried out to make the students aware about various traffic rules. Mrs Sunita Verma and Dr. Anjna Malhotra (Nodal officers Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat) made the students aware about various traffic signs which are divided into 3 categories i.e., regulatory, warning and guide signs. They told that Road safety is a matter of public health concern, and of significant importance to the government. With the goal of reducing the number of accidents due to speeding, carelessness, and drunk driving, this awareness week is organized every year. their A.B.C. Student ID. Principal Dr. Reena Talwar told that

As per the National Education Policy 2020, the Academic Bank of Credits (ABCs) is envisaged

to facilitate academic mobility of students with freedom to study in higher education institutions

of the country from one program to another with a suitable "credit transfer" mechanism and for

obtaining Degree/Diploma/PG-Diploma etc. She said that ABC will credit the credits given by

the registered institutions to the accounts of the students.

Academic Bank Credit can only be shared across institutions, not directly from the student.

Principal Dr. Reena Talwar explained the many advantages of creating ID on ABC portal such as

multiple entry for students, multiple exit allowed, student credits will be stored for minimum

shelf life of 7 years, transparency will improve and curriculum design and Will help create a

more flexible approach to development.

Mrs. Sunita Verma told many features of creating ID on ABC portal such as allowing

educational institutions to record credits and maintain their integrity,

maintaining the authenticity and confidentiality of student credits, Easy credit transfer through

digital mode, Faster credit identification etc.




